Confirmation Retreat

It is preferable that the sponsor also attend. However, if the sponsor is unable to attend then we encourage a parent to attend with their child so that they may pass along the pertinent information to the sponsor.

Choosing a Confirmation Sponsor

Due by February 28, 2018

Choosing a Sponsor for Confirmation is a very serious matter. It is not a popularity contest. You want to choose someone who you feel is a great model for you in the faith. Additionally, the Sponsor should be an individual with whom you feel comfortable asking questions and seeking advice. Understanding all of this, please keep the following requirements for your Confirmation Sponsor in mind:

1. Your Sponsor must be a practicing Catholic and have received all of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist.
2. Your Sponsor must be at least 16 years of age, and may be either male or female.
3. In order to express more clearly the relationship between Baptism and Confirmation, and to make the duty and function of the Sponsor more effective, "It is desirable that the Godparent at Baptism, if possible, also be the Sponsor at Confirmation" (Canon 893.2).
4. According to the directive in Canons 893 and 874.5, neither the father nor the mother of a candidate can serve as a Sponsor. This is because, at your baptism, your parents have already accepted the primary responsibility of raising you Catholic and educating you in the faith.
5. The chosen Sponsor should be a person who lives their faith and will provide spiritual leadership and support in addition to what parents already provide to their child. The Sponsor is someone who will challenge you to holiness and Christian discipleship.

Once you have chosen an individual based on the requirements listed above, you need to ask him/her if he/she is willing to serve as your Sponsor. If so, the following needs to be completed:

1. Enter your Sponsor's Name and full mailing address on the "Confirmation Registration Form" and return it to your catechist or the Religious Education Office no later than the date listed above.
2. Please give your Sponsor the attached letter addressed to them, the certificate of sponsorship, as well as the two copies of the Sponsor Covenant Form.
3. Have the Sponsor fill out the "Certificate of Sponsorship for Confirmation" form. This form also needs to be signed by their parish priest and stamped with their parish seal. Once this is completed, it should be returned to the Saint Therese Parish Religious Education Office by the date listed in the front of this packet.
4. The Sponsor should also fill out the "Sponsor Covenant" and return it with their "Certificate of Sponsorship for Confirmation" form. There are two copies included so that your Sponsor may keep one for him/herself.

Dear Sponsor,

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* reminds us that the desire for God is written in our hearts. This is true not only for adults but for young people as well. All people are naturally and spiritually drawn toward God.

As young people prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation, they are entering a unique stage of their spiritual journey. Preparation for the sacrament is about preparation for celebrating and living a life of faith. Adults-parents, other family members, Sponsors, catechists, members of the parish team, and the entire assembly - are privileged to journey with the young people during this time of preparation.

A Sponsor is a companion and guide who gives spiritual help and encouragement to a person who is preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation. The *Code of Canon Law* reminds us that "[t]he sponsor's function is to take care that the person confirmed behaves as a true witness of Christ and faithfully fulfills the duties inherent in the sacrament" (Canon 892).

As a Sponsor, you have been chosen to play an essential role in the life of a young person who is in the process of preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation. You may have been asked to be the Sponsor for this candidate because you are the candidate's godparent, or because of ties of friendship of family, or because you are viewed by this young person as a model of faith. Perhaps all these reasons were involved in the choice. Whatever the case, you are now embarking on a shared faith journey that can enrich both you and your candidate.

As you share in this blessed time of sacrament preparation, enjoy the time you and your candidate spend together. Keep the lines of communication open and keep your candidate in your prayers. Remember that the Holy Spirit - given to you at your own Confirmation - will be with you to help and guide you in the weeks and months ahead.

We ask that you please fill out the attached "Sponsor Covenant". Please keep a copy for yourself to remind you of the commitment that you have made. Please also take your "Certificate of Sponsorship for Confirmation" to your parish to have it filled out by your parish priest. We ask that you please mail both forms back to us at:

It is also their responsibility to assist the confirmand to lead a life in harmony with their Baptism and Confirmation, and to fulfill the obligations flowing from them.

1. Be a fully initiated Catholic who has been baptized, confirmed and has received First Eucharist.

4. Lead a life of faith in harmony with the ministry they are undertaking, and have the intention of undertaking the ministry of Sponsor.
5. Not be a parent of the candidate to be confirmed.

Choosing a Confirmation Saint Name

The Confirmandi (candidate for confirmation) should understand that a Saint's name is chosen so that the Saint becomes a model and intercessor in their life. We seek this intercession of the Saints because the Church has always believed and taught that all the redeemed are part of God's family. God's family includes the Saints in heaven; the holy souls in purgatory; and those of us on earth, who continue to persevere and grow in holiness, while living the Christian life with the help of God's grace. The Saints, however, are with God before the throne of grace. Their prayers (intercession) are very effective.

Confirmandi are strongly encouraged to choose the name of a Saint for their confirmation name. Doing this helps them to develop a relationship with a new Saint. Those of us on earth need the powerful intercession of all the Saints in heaven, who stand before Jesus' throne of grace. Confirmandi should research several Saints in whom they are interested. The parish library has many books on Saints available. Furthermore, there are numerous online resources such as:

Directions for the Letter to Bishop William Patrick Callahan

Due by April 4, 2018

There is a longstanding tradition here at Saint Therese Parish where each Confirmation candidate is required to write a letter to our bishop. The letter should tell Bishop Callahan about why you want to be confirmed, who you are choosing for your Confirmation Saint and why, and a short biography of the life of the Saint that you chose. The letter should be about one full page, typed (size 12 font), and double-spaced. There is no need to put the letter in an envelope or to address the letter as I will be mailing all of the letters together to our Bishop in one large envelope.

Directions for the Meeting with Father Louis (and Mike Lambrecht)

Each student is required to sit down for a 10-15 minute interview with Father Louis and the Director of Religious Education. The point of these interviews is to allow the students a chance to express, in a more personal way, your desire to be confirmed as Roman Catholics and to clearly understand your motivation for wanting to do so. Also, each student should be ready to demonstrate that they understand the sacrament as well as the basic elements of our faith and Christian living. A sign-up sheet will be provided during class.

Confirmation Candidate Volunteer Service Hour Form

Confirmation Candidates are reminded that at least thirty hours of volunteer service are required prior to receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. Any unpaid activity deemed appropriate by the Director of Religious Education will be accepted. In order to get credit for completed service hours, this form must be submitted for each event. The form should also be signed by the individual in charge of organizing or running the volunteer activity. Some examples of acceptable service are listed below:
