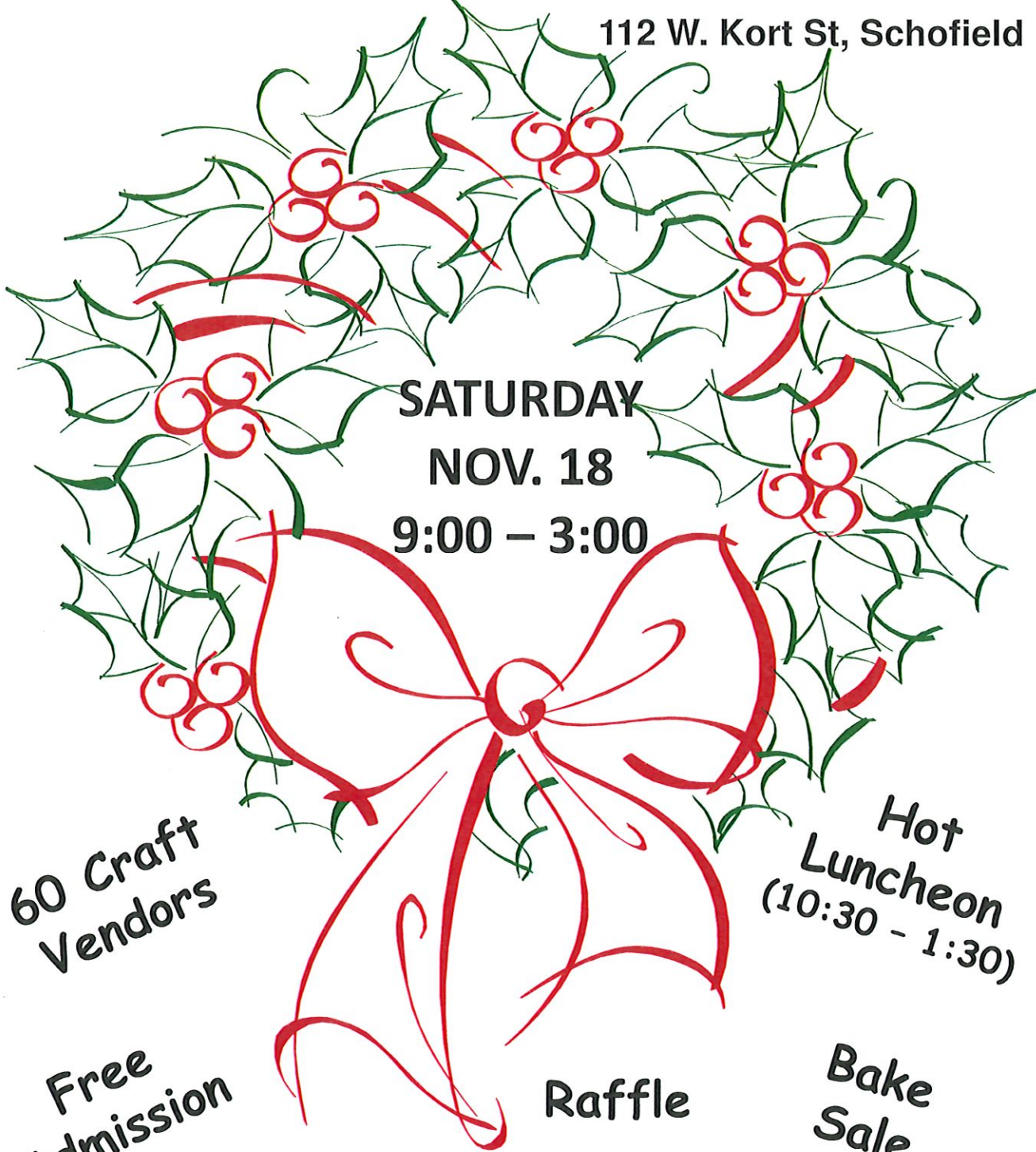

Opening Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance were said.  
October minutes were read and approved.  
Treasurer's reports for September was shared, with an ending balance of \$6,159.98.

**COMMISSION REPORTS :**

*SPIRITUALITY:* Chairpersons JoAnne and Sara were absent, No Report

*SERVICE:* LeeAnn noted that the North Central Health Center Giving Tree has been a much appreciated Service Project for many years, and we will be participating again this year. There will be 100 names for Parishoners to purchase gifts for, and Brenda Warner will help in getting the tree set up with the names of the recipients.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

*CIRCLE OF JOY:* Barb Klumpyan reported that the requests have been low, and the pantry is well stocked. She is preparing to put together 15 Christmas boxes. Announcements will be in the bulletin, and anyone who knows someone who may need food assistance is encouraged to contact Barb.

*FUNERAL DINNERS:* LeeAnn reported that there were no funerals that she was aware of. President Janet Jounie was aware of several funerals, however not sure of dinner needs.

*PARISH POTLUCK:* Janet reported that the potlucks are being well attended. Due to Thanksgiving being the 4th Thursday, the next Parish Potluck will be moved to November 30th.

*HOLIDAY SHOWCASE:* LeeAnn reported that there are a few vendor spaces left, however she does often get last minute requests for spots. Yard signs are available for anyone who may be able to help advertise the event. LeeAnn mentioned that we could use more Raffle prizes. Volunteers for help are coming forward, and anyone who would like to help out can contact LeeAnn.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

1. The Madrigal Dinner taking place on December 15th can still use volunteers for kitchen prep on Thursday and waitressing on Friday.
2. The LFC Christmas Party will take place on Monday December 4th at 6:00 pm. The Council will provide chicken for dinner, and a sign up sheet for sides, desserts and beverages was passed around. The Officers will provide door prizes. Anyone attending who wishes to participate in a gift exchange is asked to bring a \$10.00 gift. Entertainment that night will be a sing-along.
3. The Magnificat Booklets for Advent have arrived, and will be available at the Church Entrances on November 18th. Advent begins December 3.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. The school kitchen needs a good cleaning after all the constuction dust from the new flooring.
2. Copies of the LFC ByLaws and Standing Rules were provided to the members to take home for review, and are open to any corrections or suggestions. These can then be voted on at the January meeting.
3. Linda Narloch spoke about a project to crochet and donate hats, scarves and mittens to be available to parish members and families...a way to share her passion for the craft, and welcomes others to join her. Others offered to make donations of yarn as needed. More discussion will follow at the January meeting.
4. The Super Bowl Soup Sale takes place in early February. Shelly Ketchum asked for a Chair and Co-chair for this event. Kathy Pietsch came forward to help with this project.
5. Liz Joswick got a quote of \$5,000 to replace the storage cabinets in the Church basement. The Breakfast Committe will agree to pay half if the LFC pays the other half. After a short discussion and agreement on the need to replace them, a motion was made by Barb Klumpyan and seconded by Linda Narloch to commit to split the cost with the Breakfast Committee.
6. St Therese is hosting the Ecumenical Service on the Wednesday evening before Thanksgiving. Bars, cookies, coffee and juice will be served. A sign up sheet for bakers and servers was passed around.

Quarter Box Drawing was won by Barb Klumpyan.

Meeting was adjourned by President Janet Juonie.

Next meeting will be the Christmas Party on Monday, December 4th at 6:00 pm.
