

2019-2020 Faith Formation [CCD] Registration Info

Registration is necessary for all students in grades 1-10 who attend public school. Catholic school students in grades 2 and 10 should also register (for sacramental preparation). We have two ways to register:

1. Forms Available Online

- ◆ Visit our parish website at www.sttheresecc.org
- ◆ Click *Faith Formation* under *Religious Education* at the top of the page.
- ◆ Download, Print, and fill out this year's registration form.
- ◆ Mail in your form along with a check for your registration fee or drop them off in the parish or R.E. office.

2. Register In Person

- ◆ Stop by the Religious Education Office located in the school building:
 - Tuesday, August 20th from 1:00-6:00 PM
- ◆ Stop in the Church basement after all Masses on Sunday, August 25th.
- ◆ Stop by the Parish Office Monday-Friday from 8:30 AM - 4:30 PM

All families are kindly requested to fill out a new form even if they have registered in a previous year in order to ensure that we have the most current contact information on record.

Classes begin on Wednesday, September 11th at 6:30 PM.
