

# Volunteer Service Hour Form

## Requirement:

Thirty hours of volunteer service from seventh through tenth grade are required prior to Confirmation. As such, all students are encouraged to complete 7.5 hours per year. This will help to foster a habit of service and prevent the difficulty of trying to accumulate large amounts of service hours just before receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Any unpaid activity deemed appropriate by the Director of Religious Education or Youth Minister will be accepted.\* In order to get credit for completed service hours, this form must be submitted for each event. The form should also be signed by whoever is in charge of organizing or running the volunteer activity. Some examples of acceptable service are listed below:

Helping with Easter Hopping In  
Helping the Elderly  
Helping with the Parish Breakfasts  
Helping with the Parish Picnic  
Helping with Vacation Bible School  
Jubilee House  
Raking Leaves

Reading at Mass  
Serving at Mass  
Singing with a Choir for Mass  
(Practices not included)  
Unpaid Babysitting for Non-family members  
Ushering at Mass  
Volunteering with the Boy/Girl Scouts
